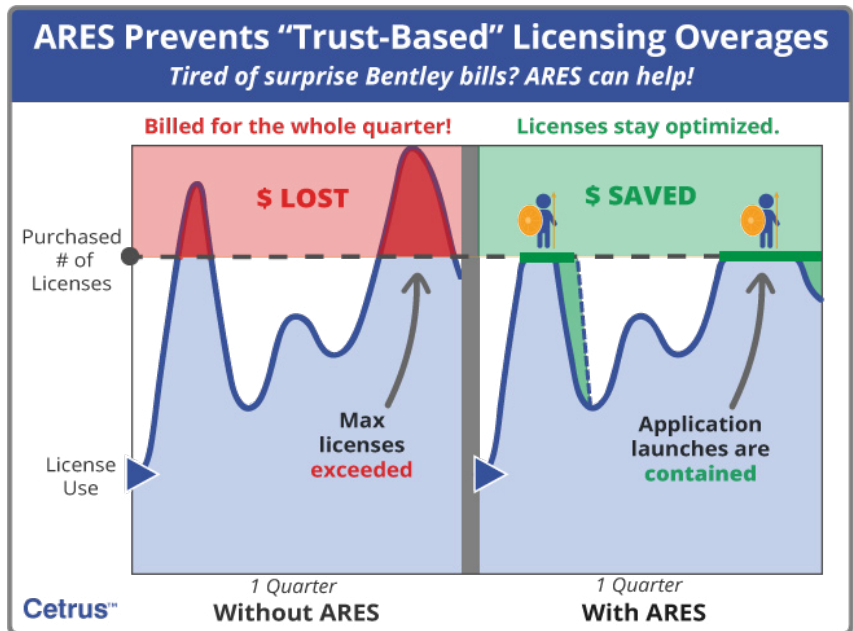
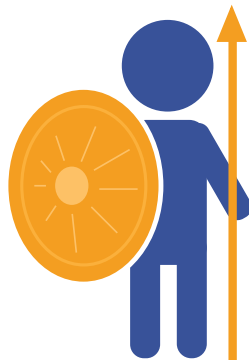
THE SOLUTION

Application REStriCTOR (ARES) is a new Plug-in to the Cetrus Process Meter (CPM) platform. When a user clicks on an application, ARES will restrict it from launching if the current number of running applications exceeds the maximum number of applications allowed. This will keep license use to the exact number purchased, preventing costly overages.

By running reports, companies can identify idle licenses, and manually release them for others to use. ARES gives you back control of your software, and helps optimize license use.
