CPM's architecture components were designed to require as few resources as possible: CPU, Memory, and network bandwidth.

Data stored in cloud

All use data is stored in the cloud.

Silent Installation

CPM installation supports customer security best practices and does not require a reboot or end user acceptance to complete the initial installation or upgrades.

Component upgrades

Customers can select whether to upgrade components automatically when upgrades are posted on the Cetrus website, be upgraded by pushing through administrative console.

Mass deployment tool support

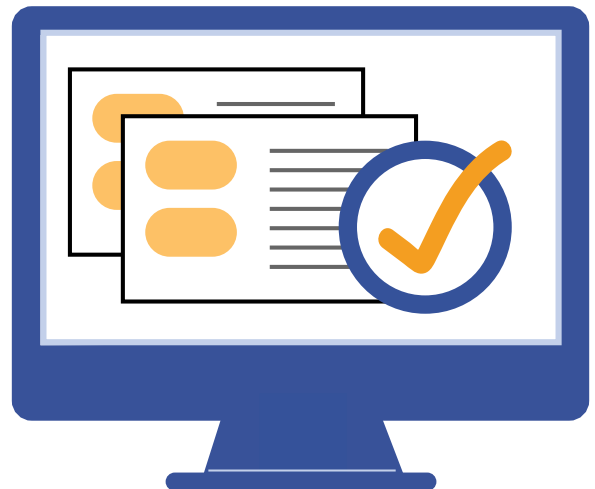
CPM supports multiple mass deployment options, including PDQ Install, Group Policy and SCCM.

Supports multiple virtualization solutions

CPM agents have been implemented in multiple virtualization technologies including Citrix, VMWare, PDQ and Advance2000.

Components isolated from desktop applications

CPM's Manager, Agent and Plug-ins are self-contained and do not interact with any desktop applications.
